ACADEMIC PROGRAMS

LASC offers four academic programs: English as a Second Language, English for Academic Purposes, TOEFL and IELTS exam preparation. Students attend classes four days a week, Monday through Thursday and can choose from morning, afternoon, and evening schedules. Our academic calendar follows a quarterly schedule with sessions every Winter, Spring, Summer and Fall. Students are welcome to enroll at any time.

TECHNOLOGY IN THE CLASSROOM

LASC prides itself in being one of the most forward thinking language schools. Much of our curriculum is e-based and students complete homework, assignments, and classroom activities using their smartphones. Teachers are able to use our Learning Management System to easily track student progress, share resources with other teachers, and gain powerful insight into the newest learning modalities. In addition, LASC is also one of the first private language schools to utilize virtual reality in the classroom where students can practice English by immersing themselves in everyday situations.

CAMBRIDGE BASED CURRICULUM

Our ESL program comprises six levels of proficiency based on a six point scale, from A1 for beginners up to C1 for the more advanced in accordance with International Standards of English Proficiency and Cambridge English Assessment. Our curriculum is corpora informed and ensures our students learn the most frequently used words and structures as they become confident English speakers.

PATHWAY TO COLLEGE

LASC currently partners with over 30 colleges and universities located in Southern California and throughout the United States. Students enrolled in our program are able to gain conditional acceptance into various institutions of higher learning. Students who complete our ESL program are eligible to enter college or university under reduced criteria and are not required to take the TOEFL or IELTS exam to be admitted.

HOW TO APPLY

F1 STUDENT

Students who are outside the United States who require an I-20 to obtain an F1 Student Visa to study in the United States.

 - Bank Statement Showing at Least \$20,000¹
 - Affidavit of Financial Support²
- 3 Pay Your Fees

After you submit your application, someone from our Admissions Department will contact you via email within two business days. Please allow 3-5 business days to receive your I-20 in the mail depending on destination.

F1 TRANSFER STUDENT

Students who are already in the United States and have a valid F1 visa and an I-20 from another school.

CHANGE OF STATUS

Students who are currently in the United States under a different visa status and wish to obtain an I-20 to change their status to F1.

 - Bank Statement Showing at Least \$20,000*
 - Affidavit of Financial Support*

 business days for your I-20 to be ready for pick up.

TOURIST

Students who are on Tourist visas who would like to take part time classes during their stay in the States.

LOCAL STUDENT

Students who are American Citizens or Permanent Residents.

- 1 Fill Out the Online Application
- **2** Upload Required Documents
 - Copy of Passport of US Passport, Permanent Resident Card, or Driver's License
- 3 Pay Your Fees
 - \$150 Application Fee

¹Bank statement must be dated within last 6 months. For each dependent bank statement must show an additional \$6,000. I-20 valid for one year.

²Only needed if bank statement is not in student's name
